## LDH Interim Isolation and Quarantine Guidance for K-12 Schools During Omicron

## If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

1. Stay home for 5 days. If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.

2. If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

3. Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then case should isolate for a full 10 days.

## If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

- 1. Students who have completed the primary series of an mRNA vaccine:
  - Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
  - Test on day 5.

2. Staff who have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months, OR have completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months, OR have been boosted

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5.
- 3. Students who are unvaccinated:
  - Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then contact should quarantine for a full 10 days.
  - Test on day 5.

4. Staff who are unvaccinated, OR have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted, OR completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted:

• Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. If school cannot ensure masking for 5 additional days, then contact should quarantine for a full 10 days.

• Test on day 5.
