Employee and Student Vaccination Policy

Addendum to the Ready to Achieve 2021-2022 Reopening Plan

Although the Virgil Browne Glencoe Charter School Board of Directors strongly encourages vaccination of employees and eligible students, vaccinations are not required for employment or school attendance.

However, the following guidelines will be in place in the event a vaccinated employee or student is exposed to COVID-19:

- Close contacts should be encouraged to seek testing immediately, regardless of vaccination status. If negative they should be tested again between 5-7 days post exposure.
- Quarantine is not necessary for individuals who are fully vaccinated (i.e., at least 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or at least 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single dose vaccination) at the time of exposure and remain asymptomatic. Proof of vaccination is required to apply this exemption.
- All close contacts, including those meeting the vaccination exemption above should continue to mask for 14 days after their last exposure in school buildings.
- If a close contact meeting the vaccination exemption becomes symptomatic, they should self-isolate immediately and seek COVID-19 testing.
